## Tips for Applying

### 1. Are you eligible?

Before starting the application process, always confirm the eligibility requirements to ensure you're applying for scholarships you are able to receive.

### 2. Prepare your documents

Each application is a little different, but you should plan to have copies of your transcripts, letters of recommendation and last year's taxes.

### 3. Write a personal statement

Most scholarship applications will ask you to share a personal statement. Write about the responsibility you have to uplift your community and what you're passionate about!

### 4. Make a list of important dates and plan to apply early

Between school and day to day life, we know that things can get crazy. Take note of important dates and start your applications early.
